PUBLIC SERVICE ANOUNCEMENT


The Ministry of Transport wishes to officially announce plans to introduce new vehicle license plates and registrations stickers that will be used in Liberia for the next five years.

The new plates will be arriving in Liberia in the early part of 2015, at which time all vehicles will be required to change their license plates. Meanwhile, pending the arrival of the new plates, those vehicles whose registrations have expired are required to carryout their regular renewal processing at the Ministry of Transport, where proper document will be provided for inspection purposes and new plate issuance upon their arrival.


- Vehicle owners wishing to register vehicles must present the following documents to authenticate ownership before a bill is issued:
 - a. Original Vehicle Title Documents
 - b. A valid Passport or any other government issued ID.

Meanwhile, the Ministry of Transport wishes to inform the general public especially owners of vehicles that beginning January, 2015, no vehicle registration document will be processed **WITHOUT** the presentation of a valid insurance certificate.
